The format is similar to receiving offerings. All ushers/elders walk slowly from the back of the sanctuary to the front in unison and turn facing the congregation.

Usher Job Description: The church usher duties can be summed up in a few words - making people feel welcome at church, assisting Pastors and teachers with people management, assisting with seating, collecting offering, and maintaining a safe environment. The outline below shows how to perform those duties.

Think of Ushers as people who welcome those who have come through the church door, provide them with a bulletin and, when needed, usher them to a seat. Assistance finding a place to sit should be offered to those in wheelchairs and those who appear to need it, especially newcomers.

◆ Usher 1, the Mass Leader, should gather the specific Mass money bag from the Sacristy and place in the back of the church by baskets. Ushers 1 and 2, who must be over 18, and not related, will both sign the security bag. ◆ Usher 1 is located in the area just inside the main entrance to greet parishioners.

Temporarily remove Bibles, hymnals, pens, information cards, etc., from the backs of chairs/pews. Post signs about not shaking hands and doing non-contact greetings.
