Patient Perspectives is a student-run program that gives first-year medical students the opportunity to speak with patients one-on-one in order to see medical care from a patient's perspective. The psychiatry branch of the program allows about 12 students, half in the fall and half in the spring, to visit the inpatient weekly to speak with patients about their psychiatric illness and how it has affected their lives.

Fourth-year medical students from the University of East Anglia (UEA) spend two months rotating through various mental health services as part of their clinical placement in the Mind Module (also known as Clinical Psychiatry or Module 11). As part of this rotation, students are placed in Old Age Psychiatry for six days over a two-week period.
