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Idaho Reading Indicator Iri Idaho

Idaho's Reading Indicator (IRI) is administered to all K-3 public school students. IRI is an early reading screener and diagnostic assessment. The screener is mandatory for Idaho public school students in the Fall and Spring with optional winter administration. Progress monitoring is available to all students.

Idaho Reading Indicator (IRI) / Assessment ...

The new Idaho Reading Indicator (IRI) by Istation's Indicator of Progress (ISIP™) early reading assessment provides reliable data with frequent, age-appropriate measurement for students in kindergarten through 3rd grade.

New Idaho Reading Indicator

The Idaho Reading Indicator (IRI) is a screener, diagnostic, and a summative assessment that also allows for progress monitoring of early reading skills. The IRI includes subtests from each of the five critical domains of reading: phonological awareness, phonics, vocabulary, comprehension, and fluency (see Appendix A).

Idaho Reading Indicator (IRI) Test Administration Manual

The Idaho Reading Indicator (IRI) is an assessment required by Idaho Statute 33-1614 to identify "at risk" students for reading failure. Research has shown that children who struggle with reading early on in their educational journey, experience greater difficulty in learning throughout their school years.

Assessments / Idaho Reading Indicator (IRI)

The IRI measures reading or pre-reading skills. Kindergarten through third-grade students take the test in the fall and the spring. The ISAT is an online test aligned to state academic standards, including Idaho's version of Common Core. It's administered every spring in elementary, junior high and high school classes.

Idaho State Department of Education (SDE)

The Idaho Reading Indicator (IRI) is a result of Idaho Code 33-1614 (enacted Spring, 1999) which states that "In continuing recognition of the critical importance of reading skills... all public school students in kindergarten and grades one (1), two (2) and three (3) shall have reading skills assessed... by a single statewide test..."

The State Department of Education is responsible for collecting and reporting results from the Idaho Reading Indicator (IRI). Staff in local schools record IRI "correct scores and skill level " (i.e., achievement level) for each student in kindergarten through the third grade in the fall and in the spring.
